Business Continuity related to “coronavirus outbreak”

We would like to inform you that our attention is intensively focused on the consequences that the Corona virus can and will possibly have and already has. Effects first of all on the supply of products. At present there is no information at Top Taste that raw materials from risk areas are not or less available.

- At this moment, there are no bottlenecks affecting the supply chain of our products.
- Neither are any problems foreseen for our deliveries in the near future.
- The supply of our raw materials is guaranteed for the coming months.

We monitor the situation continuously. Our business continuity plan will be systematically adjusted based on the available information.

In case the virus persists for a longer period of time, this will certainly lead to more practical problems at factories that make products for the food industry and possibly also for us. We will inform you in time about the options that are then available to us.

The Corona virus is now also in the Netherlands and countries around us. We keep a close eye on the recommendations of the RIVM and follow this up in order to minimize the risk of contamination at Top Taste. In addition, we have taken a series of additional measures aimed at protecting the health of our colleagues and customers in order to prevent further spreading.

We have made all our staff aware of the precautions to be taken and the good practices to adopt. As a preventive measure, we have limited access to our plant by external persons. Lorry drivers are not allowed in the building, and there is no physical contact with our staff.

At this specific moment the delivery of Top Taste/Lion Foods products is not in danger. Given the high degree of uncertainty, the situation can change at any time. This event falls outside the control of Top Taste/Lion Foods and is a case of force majeure.
